Asia–Pacific Journal of Financial Studies (AJFS) invites manuscripts for a special issue on “Chinese Capital Market”, scheduled for publication in 2022. *AJFS* became the first finance journal published in the Asia-Pacific region covered by the Social Science Citation Index (SSCI) in 2006. This special issue invites both empirical and theoretical papers in all areas of finance, with a special focus on the recent developments in the Chinese capital market, which has become a G2 economy during the last 40 years. The topics of interest for the special issue are broad, including but not limited to:

- Corporate disclosure and finance
- Uncertainty/risk and corporate policy
- Financial market regulation and reforms
- Corporate financing and investment

- Corporate social responsibility and finance
- Capital market of greater China Area
- Chinese cross-listing firms
- Chinese debt market
- Credit rating in China
- The split-share structure and its reform
- Derivatives markets
- Currency liberalization

While this special issue also welcomes submissions focusing on capital markets other than China, priority will be given to those focusing on the Chinese capital market.

AWARDS:

Up to five (8) papers will be selected and US\$1,000 award will be granted to each selected paper.

We expect to complete the review process and notify the result by June 30, 2022. Early-accepted papers may appear before the publication of the special issue, which is scheduled for December 2022.
